Group Discussion Questions

1. The apostle John was in God's Kingdom, but also in a place of suffering and extreme isolation (v.9). This was the time and place God chose to give him this Revelation. How can God use our own times of suffering and isolation to speak into our lives and reveal his truth to us?
2. (v.9) What does the phrase "patient endurance" mean to you? How can God grow us through these circumstances?
3. (V. 12-16) Jesus is described in these verses in a radical new way. How does this description of Jesus change your perception of who He is?
4. John sees the risen Lord Jesus (v.17). What was his response? How does this relate to others in scripture who personally encountered God? What should our response be when the Lord reveals Himself to us in new ways?
5. (From Wiersbe pg. 30) Revelation tells us, as Isaiah did, that Jesus Christ is the Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. What does that mean in your everyday life?
