Mark 14:12-25

1. In the original Passover feast, what did the roasted lamb, the unleavened bread, and the dish of bitter herbs each represent? What does the broken bread and wine of communion represent? Why do we celebrate communion today, but not the Passover?
2. If you had been a disciple at the Last Supper, what would you have thought when Jesus said His traitor was among you?
3. Some people try to defend Judas as a martyr, others say he was nothing more than a servant who obediently fulfilled God's plan. How do you see Judas? Explain why you feel the way you do.
4. What did Jesus accomplish by His death with respect to the Old Covenant, and the New Covenant? What does this communion have to do with our salvation?
5. Explore the word "remembrance" used in 1st Corinthians 11:24 & 25. What's the significance of this word considering that Jesus is alive?
