

Connect Group Sermon-Based Questions

Daniel 2:1-23

- 1.** In Daniel 2:1, we learn that King **“Nebuchadnezzar had such disturbing dreams, that he couldn’t sleep.”** What’s keeping you up at night? What do you do when you can’t sleep? If you had a particularly disturbing dream, who would you share it with?
- 2.** Nebuchadnezzar asked his magicians, enchanters, sorcerers, and astrologers for not only the meaning of the dream, but for the dream itself! What do you do when someone in a position of authority demands an impossible task? What did Daniel do when the commander of the king’s guard came to kill him? What application can we make in our lives from Daniel’s response? Do you have people in your life that you can share matters of life and death with?
- 3.** What did Daniel ask his friends to do? Do you have a prayer partnership with anyone (a person that you regularly share your prayer needs with and pray for one another)? If not, think and pray about someone you can have this kind of relationship with. Then, ask them!
- 4.** What verses from God’s word do you rely on to bring comfort when you face an impossible task?
- 5.** What is Daniel’s response after God revealed the king’s dream to him? Write and pray a prayer of thanksgiving to the Lord. Use Daniel’s prayer in verses 20-23 as a model. Keep it in your Bible as a reminder of the Lord’s goodness to you.
